TERMS & CONDITIONS



Neither the owners, employees, auctioneer, sale manager or other affiliated personnel can be responsible for any accidents, but they will make every effort to provide for the safety and comfort of those attending.

Health: Each animal will be represented by a state approved health certificate for interstate shipment. Buyers should make themselves aware of the health requirements for their respective states. Calves have been fully vaccinated with Pyramid 5, Nasalgen PMH3, Vision-7 and Safeguard wormer.

Insurance will be available at the settlement desk upon conclusion of the sale. Announcements made from the auction block take precedence over all printed material in this catalog.
