These numbers show how important agriculture is to the state of Kentucky and cattle producers are a large reason for that. The nearly one million head of beef cattle in the Commonwealth and the more than 33,000 farms with beef cattle, solidifies cattle among Kentucky's top commodities.

As a cattle farmer myself, I know firsthand the hard work that goes into the beef industry from bottle-feeding calves to fighting the weather. It is that experience that forms my deep appreciation for the farmers across Kentucky who make this their passion year after year. Without their continued efforts Kentucky would not have the great agricultural community that makes it stand out amongst other states.
