Exciting times in the beef cattle industry have been on a record pace for the past couple of years, and the horizon is filled with much more of the same. The productive females are expected to calve unassisted on grass, wean a big calf, and breed back within the slated calving window the following season. Hoof quality, udder quality, skeletal integrity, and fleshing ability are survival tools for remaining in the working cow herd over time. Longevity is essential for any operation to be profitable, and so the working girls within the barbed wire of the brand are the kind that keep the loyal customer base returning year after year. The grit and the ability to acclimate to any environment or terrain that is inclusive of the cattle carrying the "Bar S" drive demand for the product year after year. They run them as tough as any commercial outfit in the nation, and that is a fact.

This bull offering consists only of two-year-old and eighteen-month-old bulls developed with longevity in mind. Each bull has passed a Breeding Soundness Exam, withstood the pressures and challenges of the arid climate, and knows how to survive and adjust when turned out. This set of bulls will have the genetics and the instinct to handle large numbers of cows and leave you a set of calves that should fit both terminal and maternal needs. 
