His dam, TFA Erica G224, she is a sharp-made Brilliance daughter backed by the proven Erica cow family, bringing udder quality, fertility, and longevity. There's generations of maternal strength stacked here with Renovation, Renown, Bismarck, and Brilliance all in the mix. This bull has the look of a female-maker with enough shape and performance to push a calf crop forward. He's the kind that works for cattlemen who want to build a cow herd without giving up muscle, structure, or disposition.

SAV JAVELIN 3183 X EVENTRESS S S D43

This Javelin son is the kind of bull that fits a wide range of programs. He's built right, travels out freely, and comes backed by a cow family that flat gets the job done. His sire, SAV Javelin 3183, is known for adding muscle, body, and the kind of structural integrity that holds up over time. His dam, Eventress S S D43, is a productive Basin Payweight 1682 daughter with the udder quality and easy-keeping look the Eventress line is known for. This bull reads with practical calving ease and the kind of growth that pushes a calf crop forward, posting a +5 CED, +1.3 BW, and stretching out to +57 WW and +103 YW. Maternal traits are a strong point, with +31 Milk and solid teat and udder scores that point to daughters you'll want to keep. He's good-natured, sound on his feet, and offers a balanced carcass profile with enough marbling and ribeye to work in grid-based programs. A no-nonsense, cattleman friendly bull that combines SAV cow power with efficiency and the proven longevity of the Eventress cow family.
