In addition all bulls have passed a complete fertility exam performed prior to the sale, so you can turn out with complete confidence that your purchase is ready to go to work for you.

We offer free board and care until May first. We also offer free delivery if within 300 miles. If you live outside that radius, we will cap delivery to central points within the US to \$500.00.


