At least 2 more daughters will move into the donor pen for 2026, so whether or not she lives her days out in Newton we'll continue to build around what she does well. Her extreme look, rib cage, and muscle shape are a constant in all of her progeny! She was one of a number of impressive ewes in the Bullseye x Home Cookin' flush back in the day. Sister's are flushing well and making high quality sheep for Bartons in Utah, Beards in Iowa, and Lee in Wyoming. She's averaged 11.5 transferables in her time here, and we're confident she has a number of good years left making an impact in your flock!

She traces back just a couple generations to one of the original Begalka ewes that we started with about 20 years ago! She leaves us with an impressive set of daughters to carry her legacy, and is ready to generate out of the gate for you!

Ole Desy has been a phenomenal breeding piece for Charmasson Club Lambs. Her story started with the purchase of a Package Man yearling from MacLennan, a female he sold as Lot 1 that year. We knew right away we wanted to mate her to Manifest in hopes of creating an outcross, and that decision proved to be one of the smartest moves we've made. That mating produced Desy, along with a high-rent twin sister we reluctantly sold and have regretted ever since. Cade showed Desy that season with a lot of success, including Reserve Grand Commercial Ewe at the Oklahoma State Fair and finishing the show season as Reserve Division 1 Commercial Ewe at OYE. After seeing how well that worked, we flushed the Package Man ewe back to Manifest the following year, retaining the females as well as a ram we called Show Stopper. From that point on, we made it a priority to generate as many offspring as possible out of that line. Desy was flushed to Outsider, producing the buck Lights Out, and was live covered that same year to Quicksilver, where we retained Silver Lining.

Since then, we have continued to flush Desy every year and have retained as many daughters as we could. She has been conventionally flushed once a year, averaging 11.25 embryos over four flushes. This past year, we also did IVF for fall-borns, aspirating 13 oocytes and transferring 9 embryos.

This female flat does not miss, no matter how she is bred. We are extremely confident in her ability to continue generating elite offspring, both females and stud bucks, with the same quality, consistency, and generating power she has already proven time and time again.
